Apgar 0 at 10 minutes Vaginal Bleeding, Emergent C-Section

January/February 2008--Fetal Death (placental/umbilical perforation)

FHR 190 over 4 minutes then 60 over 5 minutes Emergent C-Section, Vaginal Bleeding/Clotting
